DINOSAURS & FOSSILS – MRS. LOWE



What are fossils? How do they form? And what can we learn from fossils? Become a paleontologist and embark on an exciting journey back through time. Stops along the way will include the Precambrian Eons and the Paleozoic and Mesozoic Eras. Students will get to see and touch a variety of real fossils dating back hundreds of millions of years. We will watch exciting videos featuring dinosaurs and even older prehistoric beasts - all the way back to the dawn of life on our planet. See how fossils are formed and make your own "fossils." Learn the techniques used in finding and unearthing fossils, then use those skills to set up a dig site and excavate bones. Uncover and reconstruct dinosaur skeletons. Every student will earn a collection of real fossils to take home and keep at the end of each two-week class session.

CREEPY CRAWLY FRIENDS – MRS. LOWE

Come explore the fascinating world of insects, spiders, centipedes, and scorpions! These tiny (and sometimes not-so-tiny!) creatures are all around us, but how much do you really know about them? Learn about the anatomy, life cycle, diet, habits, and habitats of a variety of arthropods, including both our native California species and some of their more exotic cousins. Observe preserved and live specimens - and find out about the important roles bugs play in the larger world around us. Go on a bug scavenger hunt, watch a caterpillar grow and change into a butterfly, record your observations in an insect journal, and if you're brave enough, enjoy hands-on encounters with some of our insect or arachnid ambassadors!

BRAINIACS! – MRS. WARBURG

Are you worried about summer slide? We will be doing hands on, fun learning activities to review math facts, grow stronger in our writing skills, discovering new science mysteries and exploring the world of reading. It will be an amazing time to continue learning but in summer fashion!

DANCE – TEACHER Z

With a focus in child lead choreography games, campers will learn to express themselves creatively as well as build their communication and performance skills. LANGO SPANISH – READING AND WRITING– MAESTRO REYES



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
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
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
