As announced last week, the school is currently reviewing and practicing our emergency preparedness procedures (including lockdown drills). Next Tuesday, April 18, we will practice an "emergency dismissal procedure" in which parents will park on the street and pick-up their student from the field. Such a dismissal procedure would likely be used following a crisis situation such as a fire, earthquake, or intruder. We greatly appreciate everyone's support and cooperation as we endeavor to better-ensure the safety of our students and staff. We will continue to provide parents with additional information as we move through these various drills and update our procedures.

VPS HEALTH PROTOCOLS

- A student with a fever of 100.4 or higher will be sent home and must remain off-campus the following day.
- Students who are sneezing or coughing excessively may be sent home.
- Students who have vomited may be sent home.
- A student or staff-member who tests positive for Covid-19 must remain off-campus for a minimum of 3-days and submit a negative test result (rapid test is ok) before returning to campus.
- If a particular classroom(s) has a significant number of students testing positive at the same time, then the school reserves the right to require daily testing for all students for 3-5 days.
